

Pembina 55-PLUS Curling League-Registration 2023-24

Information about Registration

The registration process for **regular curlers** (i.e., those curling full-time in 1, 2, 3 or 4 rounds of curling) in the 2023-24 season requires the completion of the on-line application for the Pembina Curling Club (PCC), **and** completion of the attached 55-PLUS League's application form.

Regular curlers should register with the PCC's on-line system before registering with the 55-PLUS League. The steps to follow in registering and paying fees to the PCC are outlined below. Please note that Spares or Social Members **do not** register with the PCC's on-line system; they complete only the 55-PLUS League's application, and if they are spares, the Waiver of Liability, and return these to the 55-PLUS League as instructed in the application form.

Regular curlers who complete the PCC's on-line application receive ongoing information from the PCC via email during the curling season (you may opt out of these messages if you wish), register your agreement with the Waiver of Liability (required by all curling leagues), and pay the PCC fees owing for the season. These fees include a \$10 Curl Manitoba fee (required of all regular curlers), a \$10 food voucher fee (returned to members as vouchers at the beginning of their season to be used in the PCC coffee shop/restaurant), and a \$25 Building Development fee set aside by the Club for major repairs to the building or ice plant when these are required. Members who curl in more than one league in the PCC no longer need to pay the Building Development fee and the Curl Manitoba fee to other leagues at the PCC, and then be re-imbursed later for these fees. Procedures to follow in paying PCC fees are outlined in the next section; ice rental fees are paid to the 55+ League, and these are outlined in the application for the 55+ League provided as a separate attachment.

Registration with the Pembina Curling Club

If you are a 'regular curler', the following steps should assist you in registering with the PCC's on-line system.

1. Enter 'Pembina Curling Club' in your browser and go to the 'Pembina Curling Club site (peminacc.com)'. Click 'Return'.
2. Select 'Sign Up'.
3. Under 'Monday' select '55+ League'. This should take you to the 55+ League 2023-2024'. Click 'Register' and then 'Login'.
 - a) If you have a gmail account, click 'Log on with Gmail' and enter your gmail address.
 - b) If you do not use gmail, enter your email in the text box and click 'Send me a Login link'. You need to wait for this email. You should be able to access this email by minimizing your current registration page. Click on the link in your new email and return to your registration page to continue. You can also use another device to access your email which will also have a code option that you can enter on your login page to allow you to continue registering.
4. The next page is identified as 'Cart'. On this page you need to select a profile to register with. If you have previously registered, you will see your profile to register with and you can press 'Select' on the right-hand side. If you have not registered before, click 'New

profile' and 'Information required'. After completing a 'New profile' or correcting 'Your existing profile', if required, click 'Save and continue'.

5. You will be taken to a page which provides the text of the Liability Waiver, which all curlers must sign. At the bottom of the page, type in 'I agree' and click 'Submit'. On the next page, ignore any reference to the 'Carefree League' and continue answering questions relevant to the 55+ League. One of the questions asks about the number of rounds you will be curling and the follow-up questions asks you to specify the rounds. To this question, indicating '1, 2, etc.' seems to work.
6. You will be taken to a page where you can review your order or add more league registrations at the PCC by clicking 'Continue shopping'. If you are only curling in the 55+ League at the PCC, click 'Complete purchase'.
7. At the end of your registration, **you must click 'Cash/Cheque'** to check out.
8. This is the last step; just click 'Submit' to complete the PCC registration process.
9. You will be taken to a confirmation page which reminds you how to make your payment to the Pembina Curling Club. You will also receive an email to the address you registered with, once again confirming your registration. If you do not receive an email your registration did not go through. Try again and if you are still unsuccessful, please contact the Club Manager at pembinacurlingclub@gmail.com. We will notify you of the date later in August when the Club Manager is available. In the event of additional challenges and you plan to attend the in-person registration for the 55-PLUS Curling League on September 6th, we will make every effort to ensure that someone is available to help with the PCC registration on that date.
10. Payment of PCC fees must be made by September 13, 2023. Payment options are noted below:
 - a) You may mail or drop off a cheque for the amount owing to the PCC made out to the Pembina Curling Club' at the office of the Pembina Curling Club, 1341 Pembina Highway, Winnipeg, MB R3T 2B6. Make sure the name you registered with is on the cheque. If you are hand delivering your cheque, and the PCC door is locked you can drop your envelope in the mailbox at the front door.
 - b) You can also send an e-transfer. If you use the e-transfer option, send this to pembinacurlingclub@gmail.com and make the password 'manitoba'. In your e-transfer be sure to reference the name you registered with.
 - c) Regular curlers who will be attending the in-person registration for the 55-PLUS League on September 6th at the PCC may pay both their PCC fee and our League's ice rental fee at the same time. If you choose this option, please note that you must issue two separate cheques - one to the Pembina Curling Club for fees owing to the PCC, and another to the Pembina 55-PLUS Curling League for ice rental fees.

Registration with the Pembina 55-PLUS Curling League

1. The attached application form **must** be completed by all Regular Round curlers, spares, and those registering as Social Members.

2. Please read and answer all questions relevant to you in the attached application, including those related to the rounds you wish to curl, and your first and second choices for curling positions.
3. No advance payment is required for those registering as spares.
4. Fees include an increase in ice rental costs of approximately five percent this year over the previous year.
5. Spares must sign and return the Liability Waiver with their application as these need to be provided to the PCC prior to the start of curling.
6. The in-person registration will be held Wednesday September 6, between 1:00 and 2:30 PM at the Pembina Curling Club (1341 Pembina Hwy). Other registration options are identified on the application form.
7. Please join us for the semi-annual meeting of the 55-PLUS Curling League on Tuesday, September 26 between 1:00 and 2:30 PM at the PCC.
8. Dates for the four rounds of curling this season are: Round 1: October 6 – November 10; Round 2: November 13 – December 15; Round 3: December 18 – January – 31; Round 4: February 2 – March 8. The Last Chance Bonspiel will be held March 11 – 22. Our weekly curling schedule is the same as previous years - Monday, Wednesday and Friday starting at 1:00 PM, with each team curling on two of these three days each week.
